ANNOUNCING THE RELEASE OF OUR FOURTH CD & THIRD DVD!

We are excited to announce the official release of two brand new recordings: new CD "Eternal Return" & new DVD "Document Live". Both recordings are available at our concerts & our online shop.

The CD "Eternal Return" features two very special guests. At the end of 2012, original teacher of Mugenkyo, Masaaki Kurumaya Sensei came to the UK to perform a joint concert. Three of these pieces have been selected for the CD, which range from the very traditional "Fukui no Taiko", which showcases the roots of the Fukui style, to the improvised "Alchemy", which explores new territory with a fusion between taiko, electronic "wave drum" and flute. In addition to being the acknowledged master of the Fukui style, Kurumaya Sensei is a great innovator, and has pioneered a range of collaborations throughout his 40-year career.

"Eternal Return" also features wonderful flautist Nobuko Miyazaki, who toured with Mugenkyo in 2011 and 2012. This recording features Nobuko on both the western flute and shinobue bamboo flute. Her ethereal sounds fit the Mugenkyo style perfectly - a collaboration which we enjoyed tremendously & was very popular with our audiences.

Earlier in the year Mugenkyo toured Japan, and two of the performances were recorded for this CD, one of which was the "Extasia Festival", where Mugenkyo was the first European group to be invited to perform at this prestigious event - a platform for the very best professional groups in Japan. The Mugenkyo performance was rapturously received, and was a seminal event in Mugenkyo history, which has been captured for this CD. The other performance featured on the CD is a concert in Fukui, where Mackie & Miyuki first trained, celebrating the 20-year relationship with Masaaki Kurumaya Sensei.

Our new DVD - "Document Live" is jam-packed with exciting concert footage from our 2012 autumn tour, and also features the special guest Nobuko Miyazaki. For a taste of the new DVD, have a look at our brand new promotional video on our website: www.taiko.co.uk

Track listing:

Belenos - Classic opener from the show, starting with quiet percussive sounds, voice and a powerful heartbeat, building to a dramatic climax.

Nagareboshi - Movements representing a shooting star

Shibu-Rokku - Featuring jazzy middle-east inspired melodies on the western flute by Nobuko, megaphone poetry and Barry's expressive gong, driven by Mackie's shiburoku beat.

Fudoshin - a two-girl Odaiko big drum piece, with Shonagh & Miyuki performing this physically challenging style

Chronos - Masked characters with streamers glow in the UV light, accompanied by atmospheric music

Tomoe - Three drummers play between four drums, in a highly choreographed style

Hibiki - Fukui style improvised solos & cross-hands "tsunami kaeshi' style. **Ushioi Uta** - a beautiful shinobue bamboo flute solo by Nobuko

Odaiko - Mackie's inimitable big drum solo

Uchiwahaha - Comedy featuring funny-man Joao, with Barry & Martin Shichisan Stomp - Upbeat piece featuring the Uchiwa hand-held drums Todoroki - 3-Odaiko big drum version of the "big rumble"

Yatai Bayashi - Stomach-crunching traditional style.

A BUSY SEASON AT THE MUGEN CAMP: DRUMFEST, FORMULA ONE & MORE!

All of our Dojo members excelled themselves at the Taiko Drumfest in March, displaying their skills to an enthusiastic audience at the East Kilbride Theatre. It was a truly memorable evening, with the unveiling of new choreography with five drummers performing with streamers, an all-girl Yatai Bayashi. Shakuhachi with Nihon Buyo dance, and a special guest spot from the East Kilbride Taiko Alba.



At the same time, the professional team was out on the road on the March "Way of the Drum" tour. For one of the concerts, they were joined by the Stirling Taiko Alba participants, who performed a short guest spot as the culmination of a teaching project. Halfway through the tour we also performed at Windsor Castle. The flag flying indicated that her Majesty was in residence, however no sight was to be seen of Liz, although no doubt the reverberations of the taiko drums resounded throughout the Castle and kept her feet tapping!

Meanwhile back at our base - the Mugen Taiko Dojo - we had a visit by "Byre Rhythm" for a masterclass with Miyuki. Based in St. Andrew's, the group have just celebrated their 10-year anniversary. Despite being the taiko group for over 50's, Byre Rhythm challenged the Miyake style of playing, proving that age is no barrier to energetic taiko playing!

In April, Mugenkyo performed at the Bahrain Formula One Grand Prix. With temperatures soaring to 40 degrees on the track, performing in the heat was quite a challenge, with several sets a day on different stages throughout the site. The performances were so popular we were asked to choreograph a finale for the awards ceremony, timed to fit perfectly with the proceedings, and televised live on Sky Sports to millions of viewers.

May and the team were on tour again, this time with the larger Mugenkyo show for a 20-date tour, introducing a new electronic instrument - the wave drum, which provided a moody landscape for the stage show. The team were joined for five of the concerts by group co-founder Miyuki Williams, who has recently taken a break from touring - a welcome return to the Mugenkyo touring lineup!

June saw the conclusion of our "Taiko Alba" project, with the fourth & final group performing onstage at the Glasgow Mela Festival. The teaching & performance project introduced the art of taiko drumming to a new group of young people in Edinburgh, Stirling, East Kilbride & Glasgow, in a project supported by Creative Scotland.

We look forward to seeing you in Edinburgh, or for one of our autumn tours!




INTRODUCTORY WEEKEND WORKSHOPS AT THE DOJO
