# HEADLINES FROM THE MUGEN TAIKO REPUBLIC!

In May following a successful 16-date tour up & down the UK, Mugenkyo were delighted to perform at the Wataniya Festival in Kuwait, in front of thousands of screaming Kuwaiti teens, along with English-Irish boy band "The Wanted". It was a spring season of jet-setting, also visiting the wonderful Festival Dell'Oriente in Milan for an 8 day festival spread over 2 long weekends, performing for a total of 48 times!

In June we had the pleasure of welcoming Byre Rhythm back to the Dojo for their annual masterclass. This time the over 50's group faced the challenge of the Odaiko, with a special practice piece taught for the huge Odaiko big drum.

Also in August we had a visit to the Dojo from the Japan Marvelous Drummers, a.k.a Kawasuji Taiko, who were performing a 3-week run at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival this year. Based in Kyushu and hugely popular in Brazil, the group wow-ed the Fringe audiences, converting yet more people to Taiko. Our Dojo members were treated to an impromptu performance up close & personal, and we all joined in with a short festival rhythm together before enjoying a tipple together here at the Dojo.

In September we spent a very productive day filming our performance team, creating new promo videos which will be available soon.

September of coure was the historic independence referendum, which split our Dojo citizens down the middle. We already think of the Dojo as a kind of independent republic anyway. But don't worry, you won't need your passports to visit the Dojo next year!
